



## PLANT INSTALLATION GUIDE

Thank you for choosing New England Nurseries. We take pride in our quality nursery stock and professional installation.

You can typically expect your installation to occur within 2 -5 weeks from the date of purchase, depending on the time of year, weather, equipment needed, and job size. Our Landscape Department will contact you to schedule your installation approximately one week before your installation appointment.

Due to unpredictable weather and unexpected site conditions on different jobs, we cannot schedule work too far in advance. We do our best to complete installations promptly and according to individual schedules whenever possible.

You do not need to be present for the installation. Whether you choose to be present, or not, please let us know which days will work best for you, and if you prefer morning or afternoon. ## WATERING ESSENTIALS

On the day of the installation, please have a hose prepared that can reach the planting site available. After installation, the new plants should be watered:

- Every day for the first week;
- Three times per week April – September;
- Two times per week October – November 15<sup>th</sup>

Watering times will vary depending on soil and location type (for example, sandy soil requires more water than clay soil.) We cannot stress enough the absolute importance that each new tree and shrub receives slow, deep watering of the entire root ball; lawn irrigation systems and quick daily watering are insufficient for the health and longevity of newly planted trees/shrubs. In typical healthy soil conditions, a 2-4" caliper tree requires about 10 gallons of water, 2 - 3 times per week. Medium to large shrubs need 5 gallons of water applied 2-3 times per week. If you are not sure about the moisture of your soil, we recommend purchasing a moisture meter. Improper and/or insufficient watering will void our one-year warranty.

## ONE YEAR WARRANTY

We offer a one-year warranty on our nursery stock *when proper care is provided*. If you have concerns about the health of your new plants, please reach out to us at the first signs of stress, and we will provide the necessary guidance. If, despite all efforts, a plant does not survive, we offer a one-time replacement with the same or similar species up to the cost of the original plant.
